Item 14: Information on RAAC (Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete)

This matter had been raised during a Parish Council, Village Hall Committee meeting. The Parish Council were seeking confirmation that the necessary checks had been carried out to the Village Hall as regular users of the Committee Room and having office space. The Village Hall Management Committee have confirmed this and there is no action required.

Item 15: Installation of fibre broadband in Mulbarton

Gigaclear are England's largest provider of ultrafast broadband to rural communities and are planning on bringing this to Mulbarton, along with Swardston, East Carleton, Bracon Ash and Wreningham. To keep the disruption to a minimum they will be using Open Reach's infrastructure, where possible.

They are currently surveying the area and considering locations for cabinet installations. An area they are considering for an underground chamber is on parish council owned land at Gowing Road.

There is currently no timescale for this work.

Item 17.2: .gov.uk email address(es)

JPAG (Joint Panel on Accountability and Governance) has updated their guide to include advice that Parish Council's should have a .gov.uk (or .org.uk) email address. This can apply to the clerk only but is also open to Parish Councillors.

Item 22: Agreement between Hopkin Homes and Anglian Water to use manhole on Parish Council land

Hopkin Homes and Anglian Water are required to come to an agreement which requires additional apparatus to be placed in the manhole cover on land owned by the Parish Council at Long Lane allotments.
